## Summer Reading Assignment

Students will read and fill out 7 reading logs over the summer.

Students should read at least 20 minutes per day (the completion of a picture book or one chapter of a chapter book should take about 20 minutes at this level). Students are also encouraged to read nonfiction pieces including magazine and newspaper articles and those pieces can be used in place of a book for up to 3 logs.

The books that your child reads should be at the student's reading level. To figure this out, have your child read a page of the book to you. If they have trouble with three or more words, then the book may be too hard.

Print and fill out the form that is available via the "Reading Log" link on the school's website.

Please include a parent/guardian signature under the "Comment" column of the log for each entry.
